The negative might be said as "She no like...," instead of "She doesn't like..." The error for the third person singular is also apparent in these examples. Vocabulary such as DO, DOES, DON'T and DOESN'T are not in the beginner's repertoire. For this reason, ample exercises and opportunities to use this vocabulary are provided. The beginner's language skills will show a marked improvement after the study of the SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE. The beginner's language skills will be more developed, and each student will be able to understand and to communicate much more effectively.
